



Please see below for coach selection criteria and procedures for the 2023 Nova Scotia Canada Winter Games Para Alpine Ski Team. See Appendix A for event dates and information.

Basic Info:

- Two coaches will be selected for the event.
- All must meet all basic and professional requirements.
- Coaches will be selected as much as possible on representation of athletes on the team.
- Unless absolutely necessary, no coach will be selected who does not have any athletes on the team.
- All NS clubs will be asked to provide a coach nominee(s) for the event by the specified date.
- Coach nominations will be used to create a pool of coaches who are available and willing to coach the event.
- Final coach selections will take place once the team has been chosen so as to properly reflect the make-up of the team.
- This is an athlete centered approach designed to provide athletes with the best possible opportunity to perform to their potential.

Basic Requirements:

- Must be actively coaching at the U14 or up level for a Nova Scotia club.
- Preferably working with Para athletes on a regular basis
- Must be able to attend the event for the given dates.
- Must be willing to chaperone athletes for the entirety of the event (from leaving NS until return to NS).
- Must be willing to oversee all meals, equipment preparation, off snow and on snow activities.
- Will be responsible for the athletes in all respects for the entirety of the trip.
 - o Travel
 - o Accommodations
 - o Meals
 - o Equipment Prep
 - o On and off snow activities
 - o All safety and well-being concerns

- Must be willing and able to attend all event related meetings
- Must be willing and able to set at the event

Professional Requirements:

- Must be a member in good standing of ACA-CSC
- Must have dues paid and all ACA-CSC licencing requirements completed
- Certification
 - o One coach must be minimum DL Certified
 - o Other coach must be minimum DL Trained
 - o Para Module an asset
 - o CADS Certification an asset
- Must have Speed Module Completed
- Must have SX Module Completed
- Must have a valid driver's licence

Discretionary Criteria:

- The HPP Committee may exercise their discretion when selecting qualified coaches based on, but not limited to, the following:
 - o Coach experience
 - Years coaching
 - Coaching resume:
 - Levels coached
 - Locations coached
 - Longevity in roles
 - Event experience:
 - National/ International events
 - FIS coaching experience
 - Major trips coached/run
 - o Representation of athletes on team:
 - Coaches will be selected based on the make-up of the team – best efforts will be made to ensure as many athletes as possible have a familiar coach with them for the event.
 - o Gender
 - Ideally, we will be sending one female coach and one coach of any gender

Application Procedure:

- Clubs must submit on behalf of interested coaches an expression of interest, commitment to attend if selected, and their coaching resume to the Technical Director at MByrne@sportnovascotia.ca by **Dec 1st, 2022**
- A confirmation email will be sent to the club and individual to confirm that the coach meets the professional requirements and that they are available for the event dates.

- Coach selection will take place on **TBD** and will be communicated via email and phone call.

Remuneration:

- Will be discretionary based on qualifications and experience.
